

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-282271

ADOPTED ON JUN 25 1993

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council hereby approves in concept the establishment of parking fees for parking lots owned by the City in areas adjacent to City beaches and Mission Bay Park and also the establishment of parking fees for parking in Balboa Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council approves in concept the following specific fees:

\$2.00 per car for the first three hours and
\$1.00 per car for each hour after three hours,
up to a maximum of \$5.00 per day; with additional
vehicles (e.g., trailers) and larger vehicles
(e.g., RVs, tour buses, school buses), to be
charged a proportionately higher fee based on
the number of normal car size parking spaces
they require.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to proceed as expeditiously as possible with the preparation of any required environmental review documents necessary to allow for potential implementation of the above specified parking fees and to return to the City Council with any such required environmental documents so that the City Council can determine whether or not to proceed with actual implementation of the fees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is further directed to return to the City Council at the time the Council reviews any such required environmental documents with proposals which would allow expeditious implementation of the parking fees


including proposed funding for the purchase of necessary equipment and other non-personnel expenses required to implement parking fees; a proposed method to expeditiously obtain the services of a qualified operator or operators for pay parking lots; as well as any proposed lease amendments which may be necessary to implement parking fees in lots presently controlled by City lessees in Balboa Park and Mission Bay Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare and submit an application to the California Coastal Commission for a Coastal Development Permit for pay parking at City beaches and Mission Bay Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby urges the Executive Director of the California Coastal Commission, in consideration of the City's application for a Coastal Development Permit, to waive the local discretionary review requirement, to expedite staff review of the City's application, and to schedule a hearing on the City's application at its August 1993 meeting.
