A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND SERVICE EASEMENTS VACATION LAW, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE JUNIPER STREET, BETWEEN CALIFORNIA STREET AND THE AT&SF RIGHT-OF-WAY, WITHIN MAP 4134-R, AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the public interest and convenience of said City require the vacation of Juniper Street, between California Street and the AT&SF right-of-way, hereinafter mentioned.

2. That it is the intention of said Council to order the vacation of Juniper Street, between California Street and the AT&SF right-of-way, within Map 4134-R, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17999-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 282313.

3. That this Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation under the provisions of the "Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law." California Streets and Highways Code section 8300 et seq.

4. That this Council hereby fixes AUG 10 1993 on 10:00 AM, in the Council Chambers on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time


