BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it is hereby certified that Mitigated Negative Declaration No. 91-0626, on file in the office of the City Clerk, has been completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), as amended, and the State guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations section 15000 et seq.), that the declaration reflects the independent judgment of The City of San Diego as Lead Agency and that the information contained in the report, together with any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by this Council in connection with the approval of the Halifax Estates.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council finds that project

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revisions now mitigate potentially significant effects on the environment previously identified in the Initial Study and therefore, that said Mitigated Negative Declaration, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to California Public Resources Code section 21081.6, the Council hereby adopts the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, or alterations to implement the changes to the project as required by this body in order to mitigate or avoid significant effects on the environment, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

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Mitigated **Negative Declaration**

DEP No. 91-0626

SUBJECT: Halifax Estates. TENTATIVE SUBDIVISION MAP, RESOURCE PROTECTION ORDINANCE PERMIT and PLANNED INFILL RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT, to allow the development of a 25-unit single-family residential project on a steeply-sloping 5.64-acre site. Located at the north end of Halifax Street in the Navajo community. R1-5000 Zone (single-family residential, 5,000-square-foot minimum lot size). (Lots 2615 and 2616, Allied Gardens Unit No. 13, Map No. 3544). Applicant: Halifax Partners

- PROJECT DESCRIPTION: See attached Initial Study.
- II. ENVIRONMENTAL SETTING: See attached Initial Study.

III. DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an Initial Study which determined that the proposed project could have a significant environmental effect. Subsequent revisions in the project proposal create the . specific mitigation identified in Section V of this Mitigated Negative Declaration. The project as revised now avoids or mitigates the potentially significant environmental effects previously identified, and the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report will not be required.

The project as proposed could have an adverse impact on biological resources, specifically 0.65 acre of Diegan sage scrub containing specimens of San Diego Viguiera. Implementation of the measures contained in the Mitigation, Monitoring and Reporting Program (Section V) would mitigate direct impacts to biological resources to below a level of significance and would substantially mitigate cumulative impacts.

During public review (March 25, 1993), the Secretary of the Interior list the California gnatcatcher as a threatened species under the Endangered Species Act. The ruling prohibits any interim "take" (harm or disturbance) to the gnatcatcher or its coastal sage scrub habitat at this time. The proposed project site contains 0.65-acre of remnant coastal sage scrub habitat along Halifax Street within which no quatcatchers were observed. In addition, the habitat is small in size and isolated from any connection to a large wildlife corridor. Therefore, the project proposes development in the area; and mitigation in the form of a monetary contribution to the Habitat Preservation Fund is proposed. This mitigation measure has not been approved by any Federal or State wildlife agencies and may not be found to be in compliance with Federal or State laws. Any permits issued for future development of the property do not authorize the applicant for said project to violate any Federal, State, or City

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laws, ordinances, regulations or policies including, but not limited to the Federal Endangered Species Act of 1973 and any amendments thereto.

IV. DOCUMENTATION:

The attached Initial Study documents the reasons to support the above Determination.

V. MITIGATION, MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM:

The following measures have been incorporated as conditions of the Tentative Map to mitigate the id tified impacts to biological resources:

- 1. The applicant shall pay the sum of \$13,706 (by means of a cashier's check payable to the City Treasurer) to the City's Habitat Preservation Fund, to compensate for the loss of 0.65-acre of Diegan sage scrub habitat from the project site. This payment shall be made before the issuance of grading permits.
- 2. The Mitigation, Monitoring and Reporting Program shall be noted on grading plans. The plans shall be reviewed by EAS to ensure that the required mitigation measure is provided.

The above Mitigation, Monitoring and Reporting program will require additional fees and/or deposits to be collected prior to the issuance of building permits, certificates of occupancy and/or final maps to ensure the successful completion of the monitoring program.
