WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego is desirous of waiving Transportation Demand Management ("TDM") filing fees for smaller employers who will not initially be involved in the proposed regional TDM program, and for employers demonstrating a high degree of ridesharing; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Demand Management Ordinance (Chapter VII, Article 1, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code), authorizes the TDM Administrator to establish the appropriate level of filing fees with the review of the TDM Appeals Board; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the TDM Administrator be permitted, with the concurrence of the TDM Appeals Board, to waive the filing fee for 1) worksites of less than 100 employees, and 2) those employers of more than 100 who demonstrate achievement of the initial trip reduction targets in the proposed regional trip reduction regulation.
