WHEREAS, the Police Department's Helicopter Program, hereafter known as ABLE, is an invaluable tool in support of field operations; and

WHEREAS, the two helicopters currently used by ABLE are rapidly approaching maximum life expectancy for this type of aircraft and should therefore be replaced as primary patrol aircraft to assure safe and uninterrupted air support operations; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized and empowered to advertize for bids on the purchase of two (2) helicopters plus related accessory equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder for the purchase of two (2) helicopters plus related accessory equipment for an amount not to exceed \$3.2 million plus applicable taxes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriation and expenditure, not to exceed \$2.3 million in FY1994 from Police Federally Seized and Forfeited Assets funds (Funds 18607, 10118, and 10119), is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for said purchase or lease/purchase of two (2) helicopters plus related

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to finance all or any portion of said purchase or lease/purchase under the Master Lease Program (adopted as Council Ordinance 0-17908).
