## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 282963 ADOPTED ON NOV 0 9 1993

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE LA JOLLA SHORES DRIVE (CALLE FRESCOTA TO RUETTE MONTE CARLO) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-282756, a public hearing was called for on NOV 09 1993 at the hour of NOV

Lots 1-2 of Block 15, lots 8, 10-12 of Block 16, lot 1 of Block 17, lot 2 of Block 18, lots 6-7 of Block 19 of La Jolla Shores Unit No. 1, Map 1913; lot 4 of Cerca de la Playa, Map 7957; and portion of lot 1297 of Pueblo Lands MM 36.

Said district shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

LA JOLLA SHORES DRIVE between a line parallel to and 100' south of the southerly line of Calle Frescota to a line parallel to and 300' north of the northerly line of El Paseo Grande; CALLE FRESCOTA between a line parallel to and 110' west of the westerly

line of La Jolla Shores Drive and the westerly line of La Jolla Shores Drive; CALLE DE LA GARZA between a line parallel to and 100' east of the easterly line of La Jolla Shores Drive and the easterly line of La Jolla Shores Drive; CAMINO DEL ORO between a line parallel to and 25' west of the westerly line of La Jolla Shores Drive and the westerly line of La Jolla Shores Drive; CALLE DEL ORO between a line parallel to and 100' east of the easterly line of La Jolla Shores Drive and the easterly line of La Jolla Shores Drive; CALLE CORTA between a line parallel to and 100' east of the easterly line of La Jolla Shores Drive and the easterly line of La Jolla Shores Drive; CAMINO DEL COLLADO between a line parallel to and 110' west of the westerly line of La Jolla Shores Drive and a line parallel to and 100' east of the easterly line of La Jolla Shores Drive; EL PASEO GRANDE between a line parallel to and 115' west of the westerly line of La Jolla Shores Drive and the westerly line of La Jolla Shores Drive. all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 26615-D entitled "LA JOLLA SHORES DRIVE (CALLE FRESCOTA TO RUETTE MONTE CARLO) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT," copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- $\frac{282756}{}$  and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and

all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.
- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- 3. The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City

Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.


