WHEREAS, The Paradise Hills Neighborhood Watch Council has developed a system of Block Watch Captains with the purpose of looking out for trouble on their respective blocks, as well as looking out for each other and reporting any criminal activity to the police and to the other members of the Watch Council; and

WHEREAS, The Paradise Hills Neighborhood Watch Council is concerned with the public safety of the area residents, especially the children, and invites speakers to their monthly meetings for the purpose of organizing, informing, educating, and developing pride in themselves as well as their neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, The Paradise Hills Neighborhood Watch Council, besides being concerned with the health and safety of their community, finds time to organize a yearly Block Party for the neighborhood residents as well as a Christmas Party for all in

the community, especially their children; and

WHEREAS, The Paradise Hills Neighborhood Watch Council members are constantly working effortlessly by way of passing out flyers, visiting the area residents to encourage them to participate in all aspects of their organization; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby commends all of the members of The Paradise Hills Neighborhood Watch Council for their outstanding leadership and dedication for the safety of their neighborhood and for their unselfish service to the community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that November 15, 1993 be and is hereby proclaimed to be "THE PARADISE HILLS NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH COUNCIL DAY" in San Diego.
