Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the City of San Diego on Jan. 11, 1994, at the hour of 10:00 am in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, san Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service in the District described above.

2. At such hearing all persons interested shall be given an opportunity to be heard and said hearing may be continued from time to time as may be determined by the City Council. The decision of the City Council as to the formation of the District as described above shall be final and conclusive.

3.
