WHEREAS, the City Manager established the Vacant Properties
Task Force in April 1993 to address the problems associated with
vacant and abandoned properties;

WHEREAS, the members of the Vacant Properties Task Force included representatives from the City Manager's Office,
Neighborhood Code Compliance Department, Police Department,
Housing Commission, City Attorney's Code Enforcement Unit, the
Association of Realtors, building and lending industries, nonprofit housing organizations and citizens from several San Diego neighborhoods;

WHEREAS, the Task Force analyzed programs and ordinances used by other cities to address vacant properties (some of these cities included Seattle, Portland, San Jose, Los Angeles, Detroit and Chattanooga);

WHEREAS, the Task Force met regularly with representatives from lending institutions, title insurance companies, non-profit rehabilitation specialists and community group to learn about their experiences with vacant properties;

WHEREAS, the Task Force developed Eight Policy
Recommendations as a result of its numerous meetings and
discussions;

WHEREAS, the Task Force held a public forum at City Heights to gain critical public input on the Eight Policy Recommendations:

WHEREAS, the Public Services and Safety Committee held a special workshop on Vacant Properties (see City Manager's Report No. 93-299, October 13, 1993) and took the following action:

- approved Task Force Recommendations One, Four, and
 Five without modification;
- 2) approved Task Force Recommendation Two, subject to further fiscal impact analysis by the City Manager;
- 3) approved Task Force Recommendation Eight to reestablish a Working Group to implement and monitor the Task Force's Recommendations and policies approved by the Public Services and Safety Committee; and
- 4) referred to the new Working Group Recommendations Six and Seven for further study and later review by the Public Service and Safety Committee; and
- 5) referred the definition of vacant properties for further clarification to be provided at the Council hearing; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the City Manager centralize the procedures within the City of San Diego to identify and abate vacant properties and design a coordinated strategy which combines abatement and rehabilitation (Task Force Recommendation One);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be directed to take the steps necessary to create the new position of a Vacant Properties Coordinator in the Neighborhood Code Compliance Department (Task Force Recommendation Two);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager build a coalition with representatives from the City Council, city entities, lenders and the community (including churches) with the mission to rehabilitate vacant properties (Task Force Recommendation Four);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager work with the Association of Realtors to develop and maintain a database of vacant properties and create and distribute a Resource Guide on financing and rehabilitation resources and assistance for property owners (Task Force Recommendation Five);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager establish an on going Working Group to implement and monitor some of the following Task Force Recommendations and Policies:

- Develop a pilot program that targets the rehabilitation of specific properties;
- Evaluate and clarify Task Force Recommendations
 Six and Seven and develop more detailed proposals for subsequent
 review by Public Services and Safety Committee;
- Integrate several new suggestions into the Task

 Forces recommendations (i.e., redevelopment corporations, housing

 commission financing and preventative strategy).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the definition of vacant properties as set forth in City Manager Report No. 93-320 be approved in full.
