ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 18032 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON JAN 31 1994

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 9, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.0907 RELATING TO SALES OF REAL PROPERTY TO PUBLIC AGENCIES TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY ATTORNEY TO SETTLE EMINENT DOMAIN ACTIONS TO ACQUIRE CITY PROPERTY WITH A VALUE UP TO \$50,000

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 9, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 22.0907, to read as follows:

SEC. 22.0907 Sales of Real Property to Public Agencies

Subject to the provisions of Section 219 of the Charter of the City of San Diego, whenever the Council shall find that lands belonging to the City are required for public purposes, the said Council may, by resolution, authorize the sale of any of said lands to any political subdivision, or public agency, without advertising for bids and without regard for any of the provisions of Section 22.0902; provided, however, that the sale shall be at such price and upon such terms as the Council shall deem to be fair and equitable and in the public interest.


The City Attorney is authorized to settle any eminent domain action brought by another public agency to acquire

City property under the following conditions:

1. The value of the property to be conveyed is \$50,000 or less; and
2. the value is established by appraisal satisfactory to the City Manager.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
