BE IT ORDAINED, that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to, on behalf of the City, agree to the DECLARATION OF COVENANTS, CONDITIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND RECIPROCAL EASEMENT AGREEMENT FOR PARK TERRACE CENTER, under the terms and conditions set forth in that form of Declaration on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00- 18046
