AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING DIVISION 30 AND SECTIONS 51.3001, 51.3002 AND 51.3003 RELATING TO RECOVERY OF INCARCERATION COSTS FROM SENTENCED PRISONERS

WHEREAS, the City desires to reduce the cost of operation of its Pre-arraignment Detention Facility by requiring sentenced prisoners to pay incarceration costs in accordance with the provisions of California Penal Code section 1203.1c; and

WHEREAS, the state legislature in California Penal Code section 1203.1c has authorized a city to adopt an ordinance for the recovery of incarceration costs from sentenced prisoners; and

WHEREAS, California Penal Code section 1203.1c shall be operative in a city upon the adoption of an ordinance to that effect by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, California Penal Code section 1023.1c requires that the city's ordinance include a designation of the officer responsible for collection of moneys ordered pursuant to that section; and

WHEREAS, California Penal Code section 1203.1c requires the City Council to include a determination, to be reviewed annually, of the average per-day costs in the city jail or other local detention facility; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding Division 30, and Sections 51.3001, 51.3002 and 51.3003, to read as follows:

DIVISION 30

Recovery of Incarceration Costs

SEC. 51.3001 Intent and Purpose

It is the intent and purpose of the City Council to adopt an ordinance making California Penal Code section 1203.1c operative in the City of San Diego in accordance with the requirements of that state statute.

SEC. 51.3002 City Manager Authorized to Collect

- (a) The City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to collect the reasonable costs of incarceration allowed by California Penal Code section 1203.1c from any defendant convicted of any offense and ordered to serve a period of confinement in a City jail or San Diego Prearraignment Detention Facility.
- (b) The City shall charge an incarceration fee from criminal defendants for each day of incarceration.
- (c) Subject to approval by the City Council and the presiding judges of the Municipal and Superior Courts, the City Manager shall determine the incarceration fee per person and shall prepare a payment schedule for reimbursement of the costs of incarceration pursuant to California Penal Code section 1203.1c. The incarceration fee proposed by the City Manager shall be based upon the actual reasonable costs of incarceration and shall be

calculated on the actual average daily cost of incarceration per person.

(d) The City Manager shall review annually the daily incarceration fee to determine whether it reflects the actual cost of incarceration. The City Manager shall adjust the fee as required, subject to the approval of the City Council and the presiding judges of the Superior and Municipal Courts.

SEC. 51.3003 Defendant Rights

Before an incarceration fee may be imposed, a defendant shall be accorded counsel, hearing and all other procedural rights provided in California Penal Code section 1203.1c.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
