ADOPTED ON JUN 20 1994

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT BOARD, CITY DOCUMENT NO. OO-15881 AND MTDB NO. L5506.0-90

WHEREAS, on October 24, 1978, the City Council, by Resolution No. 222092, approved in concept the early implementation of a Light Rail System ("LRT") as proposed by the San Diego Metropolitan Transit Development Board ("MTDB") and approved in concept the alignment for the LRT in the City of San Diego from the Santa Fe Depot at "C" Street and Kettner Boulevard, east to 12th Avenue on "C" Street, then south along 12th Avenue and the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway right-of-way to the International Boarder at San Ysidro; and

WHEREAS, on November 23, 1981, MTDB adopted Resolution No. 81-120 which adopted an eastern light rail transit extension known as the East Urban Line which follows the San Diego and Arizona Eastern (SD&AE) trackway from 13th Street and Commercial east on Commercial to 32nd Street, then along SD&AE right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, on January 3, 1983, an ordinance was adopted authorizing the San Diego MTDB to utilize certain portions of the streets of the City of San Diego, pursuant to Sections 103.1 and 105 of the San Diego City Charter, for the purpose of constructing and operating an LRT extension, known as the Old


Town Line, which follows the existing Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad right-of-way from Grape Street north along California Street to the San Diego River; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Third Amendment to Memorandum of Understanding between the City of San Diego and MTDB for Mission Valley West LRT Street Use, a copy of which Third Amendment is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 18079.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
