SEC. 103.1102 Administrative Regulations

- 6. Otay Mesa Development District Permits are issued to development projects and projects to operate facilities. The term "Development" includes the following activities: landform alteration, grading, construction or reconstruction of buildings and parking areas, provision of on- and off-site public facilities, and landscaping. The term "Operation" includes the conduct of business on a property consistent with City codes and regulations. An applicant seeking an Otay Mesa Development Permit that involves development may be charged development impact

fees for both permanent and interim uses. Fees may be prorated for interim uses.
