AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 6, DIVISION 5, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 56.54 RELATING TO A PROHIBITION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 6, Division 5, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 56.54 to read as follows:

SEC. 56.54 Alcoholic Beverage Consumption Prohibited in Certain Areas

- (b) Consumption of Alcoholic Beverage Prohibited. Unless the City Manager has issued a special event permit, it is unlawful for any person to consume any alcoholic beverage at any time unless otherwise permitted by Section 56.54, upon any public property, including but not limited to any street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, beach, seawall (including on or against the seawall), pier or any public park within the following limits of The City of San Diego, including all sidewalks along the outer perimeter of such areas.
