AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-18089 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1994-95 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-18089, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS DEPARTMENT BY EXEMPTING ONE (1.00) COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE II POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department has requested the addition of one (1.00) Council Representative II position to its fiscal year 1995 budget; and

WHEREAS, it was further requested that this position be exempted from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, a review of the position indicates the nature and duties of said position is consistent with the unclassified criteria set forth in Charter section 117(a)17; and

WHEREAS, it is now requested that said position be exempted from the Classified Service pursuant to the Charter provisions; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on November 9, 1994, and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said reclassification; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission in its memorandum to the City Council, dated November 9, 1994, attached hereto as Attachment A, the Council Representative II position authorized in the Intergovernmental Relations Department for fiscal year 1994-95 is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-18089 (NEW SERIES), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1994-95 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-18089, as adopted and amended therein, by amending the personnel authorization schedule for the Intergovernmental Relations

Department to reflect therein the Council Representative II position as being in the unclassified service.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 02.5, 02.6, 02.7 and 02.8 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Miscellaneous Category D, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. O-18089 (NEW SERIES), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

SUBJECT: Exemption of an Administrative Assistant to the Director of Operations  
Position from the Classified Service

---

On November 9, 1994, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Intergovernmental Relations Department to exempt an Administrative Assistant to the Director of Operations position from the classified service. The position will be funded from savings generated from unfilled positions within that department. It will play a significant role in developing, implementing and administering the policies and programs of the department as directed by the Mayor and City Council.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating and administering department policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities of this position, the Commission finds that it meets the intent of Charter Section 117. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
