BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 3, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 23.0304 to read as follows:

SEC. 23.0304 Acceptance and Rejection of Applications

(Rule II, Section 4 of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission)

(1) and (2) No change.

(3) Applications shall be stamped with the date and time of filing in the office of the Commission and must be filed within the prescribed time limits, unless waived for good cause.



Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
