following manner, in an amount not to exceed \$16,689,700.00 from the Clean Water Sewer Revenue Fund 41509, CIP No. 42-910.1:

a) \$8,522,264.00 from FY 1994 appropriations; b) \$8,167,436.00 from FY 1996 appropriations contingent upon Council appropriating funds for this purpose in the FY 1996 CIP budget, is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for providing funds for said project and related costs, provided that the funds necessary for each such expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury. Funds are available due to reimbursement of past costs from issuance of bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, stating for the record, that the previously certified Environmental Impact Report (DEP EIR No. 91-0516) for the North City Water Reclamation Plant was reviewed and considered for this action.
