

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- **283328**

ADOPTED ON **JAN 31 1994**

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego and the Mayor's Office have established a community task force to plan the Second Annual State of the City Address; and

WHEREAS, the task force has selected the evening of January 13, 1994 to conduct the Address by Mayor Golding; and

WHEREAS, to pay for the expense of the State of the City Address, funds need to be raised, a budget needs to be approved and the City Manager may need to execute contracts for and on behalf of The City of San Diego, providing that limitations on expenditures be restricted to the amount of money received as donations; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the provisions of Council Policy 100-2 are hereby waived to allow receipt of donations for the Annual State of the City Address on January 13, 1994.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to establish a special fund to record all revenues and expenditures of the event and thereafter deposit any excess donations in the General Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all contracts necessary regarding the event, said contracts to be funded to the extent of monies donated and received by the Auditor and Comptroller.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby
approves the proposed budget for the event on January 13, 1994.
