WHEREAS, the South Encanto Neighborhood Council has developed a system of Block Watch Captains which has been instrumental in the reporting and apprehension of criminals by the police; and

WHEREAS, the South Encanto Neighborhood Council has organized a yearly Block Party for the neighborhood residents to recruit new members and inform the public of the Council's activities; and

WHEREAS, the South Encanto Neighborhood Council continues to work with other neighborhood councils and government agencies to keep their neighborhood safe and clean; NOW, THEREFORE,


