

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 283429

ADOPTED ON FEB 22 1994

WHEREAS, the federal Base Realignment and Closure Commission (BRAC) and President Clinton have recommended that San Diego's Naval Training Center (NTC) be closed; and

WHEREAS, the federal Office of Economic Adjustment (OEA) is designated by the Department of Defense to provide technical and financial assistance to local jurisdictions for planning of civilian reuse of closed military bases; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Economic Adjustment recommends that a reuse planning committee be formed to provide a forum for citizen input, facilitate coordination among the military, federal and state agencies involved in the process and to advise planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, the OEA also provides federal grant assistance for local jurisdictions which can be used for staffing, operating, administrative and public information costs associated with reuse planning; NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it hereby recognizes the Mayor's Reuse Planning Committee as the appropriate vehicle to determine the community's priorities regarding the reuse of NTC and to guide planning efforts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit federal and/or state grant applications where funds are available for planning and

implementation of the NTC reuse plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council acknowledges that the City will be required to provide 25 percent matching funds for any federal monies received, and that additional Council authorization for such matching funds will be required, unless monies are set aside and available in a Council-approved City budget for such purpose.
