BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that after full and complete public discussion and deliberation, Barbara Bry is hereby elected to the Board of Directors of the

San Diego Data Processing Corporation, for a term ending July 1, 1995, in the category of Finance, replacing Edward F. Martin, who has resigned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that after full and complete public discussion and deliberation, Ross J. Schwartz is hereby reelected to the Board of Directors of the San Diego Data Processing Corporation in the Law category, for a three-year term ending July 1, 1996.
