ADOPTED ON APR 18 1994

WHEREAS, QUALCOMM was founded in 1985; and

WHEREAS, QUALCOMM has been a leader in the production of digital wireless communications technologies; and

WHEREAS, QUALCOMM employs over 1,300 personnel at its San Diego headquarters in the Design Center in Sorrento Mesa with contracting throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, QUALCOMM's advanced OmniTrac, a two-way mobile satellite communications and tracking system, provides data transmission to over 245 transportation companies and other mobile customers operating more than 60,000 terminals in the United States, Canada, and Europe; and

WHEREAS, QUALCOMM's Code Division Multiple Access (CDMA) product, the next generation technology in communications, improves voice quality and increases capacity by as much as 10% to 20% over other systems; and

WHEREAS, a joint venture between QUALCOMM and Loral Aerospace Corporation developed Globalstar, a low-earth orbit satellite-based, cellular-like voice and data service for mobile and fixed applications; and

WHEREAS, QUALCOMM's government products include Data Link Systems for government test and training ranges, and the QM6100 Universal Compatible Modem for Defense Satellite Communication Systems; and

WHEREAS, Eudora, an electronic mail application delivers full function interoperability between Macintoshes and PCs across TCP/IP networks, and is calibrated from smaller local area networks to the largest wide area network; and

WHEREAS, QUALCOMM and its employees have distinguished themselves and have brought worldwide recognition to San Diego's reputation as a high technology center; and

WHEREAS, QUALCOMM and its employees deserve the recognition of the San Diego City Council for QUALCOMM's international role as a leader in high technologies; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize QUALCOMM's outstanding achievements and its corporate presence in The City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that April 14, 1994 be and is hereby proclaimed to be "QUALCOMM DAY" in The City of San Diego.
