RESOLUTION NUMBER R-283783 ADOPTED ON MAY 021994

WHEREAS, Section 8330, et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets by City Council resolution where the portion of street to be vacated is excess right-of-way which is unimproved and has been impassible to vehicular traffic for the preceding five consecutive years and no money was expended for maintenance on the portion of the street to be vacated for the preceding five years; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of the easterly portion of Third Avenue between Redwood Street and Quince Street, adjacent to Lots "A" - "F" of Block 353 of Horton's Addition; and

WHEREAS, the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, the portion of street to be vacated is not needed for present or prospective public street purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated will continue to have access; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the easterly excess portion of Third Avenue between Redwood Street and Quince Street, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17077-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- $\frac{283783}{1}$, which is by this reference

incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.

- 2. That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, from vacation and abandonment, easements, and rights of any public utility pursuant to any existing franchise or renewals thereof, at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew, and enlarge overhead or underground lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other structures, equipment, and fixtures for the transportation and distribution of electrical or electronic energy and natural gas, and for incidental purposes including access to protect the property from all hazards in, upon, over, and across the above-described portions of streets to be vacated and abandoned.
- 3. That the easement reserved herein is in, under, over, upon, along, and across a portion of Third Avenue vacated by this document and as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17077-B, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 283783
- 4. That the resolution shall not become effective unless and until the following condition has been met:

Relocation of the water meter serving 3065 Third Avenue into the public right-of-way.

In the event that the relocation of the water meter is not assured and completed with eighteen (18) months following adoption of this resolution, this resolution shall become void and of no further force or effect.

5. That the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the completion of the aforementioned condition, and the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, with drawing, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.
