WHEREAS, in the second week of May, 1994, it is anticipated that the House Subcommittee on Surface Transportation will authorize certain highway project funding in FY 95, FY 96 and FY 97, under the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA); and

WHEREAS, State Route 905 and State Route 56 are included in a list submitted by San Diego's Congressional delegation to the House Subcommittee for consideration for inclusion in the authorization; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has been asked to clarify the importance of the SR-56 project to its overall transportation plan, all as set forth in Intergovernmental Relations Department (IRD) Report No. 94-13, dated April 20, 1994; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council hereby states that State Route 905 and State Route 56 share a high priority in the development of San Diego's transportation infrastructure, and that it is equally important to fund, construct and complete both State Route 905 and State

Route 56, and all highway improvements related to both projects, as soon as possible, all as set forth in IRD Report 94-13, dated April 20, 1994.
