## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-283846 ADOPTED ON MAY 9, 1994

WHEREAS, tenancy issues related to the Hall of Champions occupying a refurbished Federal Building have been before Council on several occasions; and

WHEREAS, at issue is how the displaced Federal Building users will be accommodated in other facilities and whether a replacement for the Federal Building will be constructed and, if so, where it will be located; and

WHEREAS, several potential sites for the Federal Building replacement have been identified and evaluated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Council hereby commits to the construction of a new Balboa Park Activity Center on Inspiration Point at the site of the former Navy Hospital Maintenance Yard.
- 2. The Council hereby commits to the operation of the Federal Building as a public use facility through July 31, 1995 with possession of that building transferred to the Hall of Champions on August 1, 1995.
- 3. The Council hereby commits to the temporary use of the Municipal Gymnasium to house current Federal Building activities until a replacement is built.
- 4. The Council hereby approves in concept to the construction of a facility adjacent to the proposed San Diego Entertainment and Sports Center to house the USA Volleyball Teams

and support basketball facilities so long as the USA Volleyball Teams remain in San Diego.

The Council hereby refers to the Public Facilities & Recreation Committee, the Balboa Park Committee, and the Park & Recreation Board for further review the matter of razing the existing Municipal Gymnasium, with the inclusion of one preferred site, or if necessary two sites, for use by basketball players who presently use various Park and Recreation facilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$321,000 from CIP No. 21-834.0, Balboa Park/Mission Bay Park Requirements, Transient Occupancy Tax Fund No. 102242, is hereby authorized, solely and exclusively to complete such Municipal Gymnasium improvements necessary to accommodate current Federal Building activities.
