BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure in an amount

not to exceed \$9,966,580 from Sewer Revenue Fund 41508 CIP No. 46-129.0 for the purpose of executing the construction contract and related costs, contingent upon issuance of an Auditors Certificate, in the following manner:

- A) Phase 1: \$3,986,632 from FY 1995 appropriations contingent upon Council appropriations funds for this purpose in FY 1995 CIP.
- B) Phase 2: \$3,787,944 from FY 1996 appropriations contingent upon Council appropriating funds for this purpose in FY 1996 CIP.
- C) Phase 3: \$2,192,004 from FY 1997 appropriations contingent upon Council appropriating funds for this purpose in FY 1997 CIP.
