WHEREAS, The San Diego Chapter of the American Association of Retired Persons ("AARP") was established on May 22, 1992 under the leadership of Cynthia Parks and consists of eighty members; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby commends the San Diego AARP Metro Chapter No. 4916 and its members for being a part of the second largest organization in the United States.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that May 14, 1994 be and is hereby proclaimed to be "SAN DIEGO AARP METRO CHAPTER NO. 4916" in San Diego.
