- 2. Category IV, Sand bed cake to sanitary landfill disposal, an estimated 100,000 tons at a cost of \$34.95 per ton for a total estimated cost of \$3,495,000.00; (with a range of from 50,000 to 150,000 tons and a price range of from \$1,747,500 to \$5,242,500).
- 3. Category V, Screenings to sanitary landfill disposal, an estimated 4,000 tons at a cost of \$34.95 per ton for a total

estimated cost of \$139,800.00; (with a range of from 2,000 to

6,000 tons and a price range of from \$69,900 to \$209,700).

4. Category VI, Grit to sanitary landfill disposal, an estimated

3,400 tons at a cost of \$34.95 per ton for a total estimated

cost of \$118,830.00; (with a range of from 1,700 to 5,100 tons

and a price range of from \$59,415 to \$178,245).

For a total estimated annual cost of \$7,248,630.00; (with a

total estimated price range of from \$5,624,315 to

\$10,872,945); terms net 30 days; with options to renew for

three additional one year periods subject to the escalation

terms specified in the bid document.

5. In the event the contractor is unable to meet the

specifications of the contract, authorizing the PURCHASING

AGENT to terminate the contract and award to the next low

responsible and responsive bidder, and to subsequent bidders,

if necessary, until a bidder is found who can comply with

specifications.
