## Mitigated Negative Declaration

SUBJECT:

Darby Downs. CARMEL VALLEY PLANNED DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT PERMIT, RESOURCE PROTECTION PERMIT, TENTATIVE MAP, and STREET VACATION (DEP No. 91-0122) to demolish an existing 1,800 square foot single-family residence and pool and subdivide the 1.24-acre site into eight lots for the construction of seven single-family residential units. An open space lot would also be provided to accommodate a private driveway and a landscaped buffer on the northern property boundary. The site is located at the terminus and east of Old El Camino Real in the Carmel Valley community (Portion of southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 7, Township 14 south, Range 3 west). Applicant: Commonwealth Companies, Inc.

## III. DETERMINATION:
