
WHEREAS, on June 20, 1994, the City Council Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations reviewed and approved on a 3-0 vote (Golding and Roberts not present) the Intergovernmental Relations Department Report No. 94-18, dated June 20, 1994, concerning Senate Joint Resolution 44: State Sovereignty Resolution under the 10th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution, which is California's "notice and demand to the federal government" to cease mandates that "are beyond the scope of its constitutionally delegated powers"; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Council supports Senate Joint Resolution 44.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Intergovernmental Relations Department is directed to convey the City's support of Senate Joint Resolution 44 to the appropriate elected officials in Sacramento and Washington, DC.
