BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Attorney is hereby directed to prepare the necessary language to submit to the voters at the November 8, 1994, election a proposition increasing the City's 1995-96 Tax Appropriations limit by \$50 million, with annual adjustments, as provided by state law, for fiscal years 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99.
