RESOLUTION NUMBER R-284341 ADOPTED ON JULY 25, 1994

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE SITING OF A NEW MAIN LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, the Public Facilities and Recreation ("PF&R")

Committee and the Board of Library Commissioners have held a

series of public input meetings concerning the siting of a

proposed new main library as part of the implementation of

Proposition N on the November 6, 1990 ballot; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 1994, the PF&R Committee approved a motion to place two alternative sites - Mission Valley and downtown - on an upcoming City-wide ballot for an advisory vote of the People; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager concurred in the PF&R Committee's recommendation; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of August 1, 1994, the City Council took testimony on the siting of a new main library as well as on the issue of financing a new main library and improvements to several branch libraries; NOW, THEREFORE,

In light of the documents and testimony presented to the Council on August 1, the Council hereby determines that it is in the City's best interest not to seek an advisory vote at the November 1994 election as to the siting of a new main library.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the decisions pertaining to the siting of the new main library should be held in abeyance until

financing options are explored as set forth in Resolution No. RR-284340.
