A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE DELEGATION OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM TO THE SAN DIEGO HOUSING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 requires that participating jurisdictions utilizing federal housing monies create a Comprehensive Affordability Strategy (CHAS) to address affordable housing needs over a five-year period; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is such a participating jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-279138 on December 9, 1991, and as amended by Resolution No. R-283073 on November 29, 1993, the Council of The City of San Diego has approved a CHAS for the period 1993-1998; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said adopted CHAS, the City, through its Housing Commission, provides various affordable housing activities, and through its Housing Commission administers its affordable housing programs funded under the federal HOME Investment Partnerships Program (the HOME Program); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development

(HUD) desires the City of San Diego to confirm the role of its

City of San Diego Housing Commission in the administration of the

HOME Program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that:

- 1. The City of San Diego hereby confirms that the administration, planning, coordination, operation, and implementation of all activities and actions encompassed by the City of San Diego's HOME Program has been delegated to the San Diego Housing Commission.
- 2. The City of San Diego hereby authorizes the Executive Director of the San Diego Housing Commission to execute all necessary documents required by HUD, on behalf of The City of San Diego, relating to the HOME Program.
 - 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
