RESOLUTION CONSIDERING THE PROTESTS,  
APPROVING MODIFIED MAP, CONFIRMING THE  
ASSESSMENTS, AND ORDERING THE PROPOSED  
MAINTENANCE, IN THE MATTER OF THE SAN YSIDRO  
BOULEVARD LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT  
NO. 1.

WHEREAS, the notice of the time and place fixed for the hearing of protests in the matter of "San Ysidro Boulevard Landscape Maintenance District No. 1," under Resolution of Intention No. R-284013, adopted on June 6, 1994, having been duly given in the manner required by law and the legal time for filing such protests and the time fixed for hearing thereon having passed; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The majority protest of the property owners of the proposed annexation area is hereby acknowledged by the City Council and the proposed annexation of area to the San Ysidro Boulevard Landscape Maintenance District is therefore rejected.

The City Manager is directed to proceed with all other aspects of the district. All other protests shall be and are hereby overruled.

2. Except as modified herein, the assessments described in Document No. RR-284014, on file in the office of the City Clerk and on file in the office of the Street Superintendent, are hereby confirmed and approved.

3. With the exception of the annexation area, the modified assessment district map for the "San Ysidro Boulevard Landscape Maintenance District No. 1," described in Document No. M-339-1 is hereby approved.

4. The maintenance described in said Resolution of Intention is hereby ordered performed.
