WHEREAS, a young man named Willie James Jones was tragically murdered on June 17, 1994, in a drive-by shooting; and

WHEREAS, Willie James Jones was his high school's valedictorian and Aaron Price Fellow, a California Scholastic Federation member and a recipient of the Alpha Phi Alpha Academic Award and represented the best attributes possible in the community and among his fellow high school students; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to memorialize Willie James Jones so that, despite his tragic death, he may in some way continue to be an inspiration to the young people of our City; and

WHEREAS, naming a street after Mr. Jones would, in at least a small way, memorialize his exemplary life and accomplishments;

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that as a tribute to the life and accomplishments of Willie James Jones, Ozark Street is hereby changed in name to WILLIE JAMES JONES AVENUE.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the requirements regarding petitions, circulation and sign-off by affected property owners contained in Council Policy 600-12 are hereby waived and the City Manager is hereby directed to take whatever actions are

necessary, within the confines of the City budget, to accomplish  
the name change and install new street name signs.
