## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 284665 ADOPTED ON OCT 3 1994

WHEREAS, the Arts and Humanities enhance and enrich the lives of all Americans; and

WHEREAS, the Arts and Humanities affect every aspect of life in America today including the economy, social problem-solving, job creation, education, creativity, and community liveability; and

WHEREAS, local arts agencies across America have joined with the National Assembly of Local Arts Agencies (NALAA), National Assembly of State Arts Agencies and a coalition of over 50 national arts and humanities organizations representing over 23,000 cultural organizations to form the National Cultural Alliance to develop a multi-year public awareness campaign on the availability and importance of the humanities and arts to all Americans; and

WHEREAS, the campaign and its theme, "The Arts and Humanities: There's Something In It For You," was introduced to the public in the Fall of 1993 and will be ongoing for three years; and

WHEREAS, the nation's 23,000 cultural organizations, the National Endowment for the Arts, the National Endowment for the Humanities, the nation's 3,800 local arts agencies, the Arts and Humanities councils of the 56 states and United States jurisdictions, and the President of the United States will be

encouraged to participate in this celebration and in the public awareness campaign; and

WHEREAS, the month of October 1994 has been designated as Arts and Humanities Month; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby proclaims the month of October to be "ARTS AND HUMANITIES MONTH" in The City of San Diego.
