

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-284696

ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 3, 1994

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, in cooperation with law enforcement agencies of local municipalities, the County of San Diego, the State of California and various federal agencies, has formed the Violent Crimes Task Force for San Diego and Imperial Counties; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department is participating in the Violent Crimes Task Force as the lead agency and has been asked by the United States Department of Justice to become the lead agency in terms of administering the financial aspects of the task force as they relate to the procurement of supplies and equipment, and payment for incidental expenses of the task force; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be from funds of the United States Government and will be deposited in advance or promptly reimbursed by the federal government as enumerated in a separate agreement between the City and the United States Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of The City of San Diego will benefit from the Violent Crimes Task Force which operates in an efficient and expeditious manner; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the United States Department of Justice and local law enforcement agencies to create the Violent Crimes Task

Force for San Diego and Imperial Counties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a Violent Crimes Task Force Fund for receipt and expenditure of funds in connections with the Violent Crimes Task Force.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to provide purchasing services for the Violent Crimes Task Force; to negotiate a lease at the cheapest price possible; to authorize expenditure of initial equipment outlay; is directed to return to Council on individual items exceeding \$100,000 and to provide Council with a progress report in six (6) months.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is authorized to approve expenditures for procurement of equipment and supplies, and for incidental expenses for the Violent Crimes Task Force.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the requirement of the City purchasing process that any expenditure of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or more be submitted for Council approval is hereby waived solely and exclusively for the purpose of expediting the procurement process for the above project.
