BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that on the occasion of the 219th Anniversary of the United States Marine Corps, this Council is proud and honored to recognize the men and women of our Marine Corps by declaring November 10, 1994 to be "UNITED STATES MARINE CORPS DAY" in The City of San Diego.
