WHEREAS, Carmelita has been called the "Mother of Mission Bay" because of her involvement in the development of the largest aquatic park in the world from the beginning; and

WHEREAS, Bern and Carmelita have been active in many other civic activities including the successful effort to urge the state legislature to name BENITOITE as the state gem of California; NOW, THEREFORE,
