

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 284944

ADOPTED ON NOV 28 1994

WHEREAS, 2,300 American military personnel lost their lives as a result of the attack on Pearl Harbor on the island of Oahu, Hawaii on December 7, 1941; and

WHEREAS, the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association was founded in 1958 as a non-profit organization dedicated to "Remembering Pearl Harbor and Keeping America Alert"; and

WHEREAS, the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association is committed to maintaining allegiance to the government of the United States of America and fostering patriotism; and

WHEREAS, members of the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association have contributed countless hours of community service to worthwhile organizations and charities; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has proclaimed December 7, 1994 to be National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby proclaim December 7, 1994 to be "**PEARL HARBOR REMBRANCE DAY**" in the City of San Diego to honor all members of the United States Armed Forces who perished in the attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association flag will fly over the proceedings of the December 5, 1994 meeting of the City Council in tribute to the American

service members who lost their freedom defending the principles
of the United States of America.
