CITY WATER RECLAMATION PLANT TRANSLUCENT PANELS, provided that the City Auditor first furnishes a certificate demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure under said contract are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure, \$1,014,000.00 from CIP 42-910.1, NCWRP, is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for providing funds for said project and related costs, provided that the City Auditor first furnishes one or more certificate(s) demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure under established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit in the City treasury; and authorizing the Auditor and Comptroller upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
