RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 285109 ADOPTED ON DEC 12 1994

WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets and public service easements by City Council resolution where the portion of the street to be vacated is excess to the City's right-of-way needs and is no longer required for street or highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of the westerly excess portion of Seventeenth Street between "E" Street and "F" Street and adjacent to Block 8 of Culverwell's Addition, Map 143, to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, the portion of street to be vacated is not needed for present or prospective public street purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the vacation be conditioned upon completion of public improvements adjacent to the affected properties; and

WHEREAS, the vacation or abandonment is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the westerly excess portion of Seventeenth Street between "E" Street and "F" Street and adjacent to Block 8 of Culverwell's Addition, Map 143, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 24129-D on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 285109, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.
- 2. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.


