- 3. That the Planning commission be directed to hold a public hearing on the matter of the proposed amendments to Municipal Code sections 101.0404, 101.0421.1, 101.0427, 101.0428 and 101.0510 and immediately transmit its recommendations

concerning those amendments to the City Council following the hearing.
