AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 2,
DIVISION 2, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 62.0205 RELATING TO
PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, December 12, 1994, has been declared "Regulatory Relief Day;" and

WHEREAS, one purpose of Regulatory Relief Day is to streamline and consolidate, where appropriate, the City's land use and environmental regulatory procedures; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's Office has reviewed San Diego Municipal Code section 62.0205 having to do with public rights-of-way, and has suggested several amendments to the code section to streamline the regulatory process; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 2, Division 2, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 62.0205, to read as follows:

SEC. 62.0205 Acceptance of Dedications

No reservation for public rights-of-way shall be offered for dedication unless such offer includes the necessary slope easements required for the ultimate development of the right-of-way, and no such reservation shall be accepted for dedication by the City until

improvements therein are constructed pursuant to the requirements of this Code.

The City Engineer, or other designee of the City Manager, may accept on behalf of the City Council streets and roads, or portions thereof, into the City street system and record conveyances to the City of real property interests for street and road uses and purposes. No street shall be accepted into the City street system and open to public use until the street has been constructed pursuant to the requirements of this Code or construction of such street has been assured by contract or other device that has been approved by the City Engineer and City Attorney.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
