

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 18180 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON MAY 30 1995

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 6,
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING
SECTION 56.54 RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION
OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN PALM RIDGE PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 6, of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending
Section 56.54, to read as follows:

**SEC. 56.54 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION
PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN AREAS**

(a) [No changes in text.]

(b) Consumption of Alcoholic Beverage Prohibited.

Unless the City Manager has issued a special event
permit, it is unlawful for any person to consume any
alcoholic beverage at any time unless otherwise
permitted by Section 56.54, upon any public property,
including but not limited to any public street,
sidewalk, alley, plaza, beach, seawall (including
on or against the seawall), pier, or any public park
within the following limits of The City of San Diego,
including all sidewalks along the outer perimeter of
such areas.

The areas set forth in Section 56.54(b)(1)-(5)
are particularized on maps on file in the office of
the City Clerk as Document No. 00-17655-2.

(1) - (5) [No changes in text.]

(6) The following areas, beaches, parks, parking lots, boardwalks, seawalls (including on or against the seawall), and public rights-of-way within and immediately adjacent to them are specifically included in the ban on consumption of alcohol at any time, unless otherwise permitted by Section 56.54:

Street;


(B) the 5000 block of Newport
