

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- **18183** (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON **JUN 12 1995**

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 1995.

WHEREAS, in November 1992, the voters approved Proposition E, which amended San Diego City Charter section 12; and

WHEREAS, as amended in November 1992, Charter section 12 (d) requires that at the municipal primary and general elections in 1995, Councilmembers for Districts 2, 4, 6 and 8 be chosen by the electors for a term of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, in the year 1995, the Municipal Primary Election will be held on the 19th day of September, and the General Municipal Election will be held on the 7th day of November; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in The City of San Diego on Tuesday, September 19, 1995, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices in accordance with Charter sections 10 and 12:

- COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 2 three-year term
- COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 4 three-year term
- COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 6 three-year term
- COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 8 three-year term

Section 2. It is further ordered that, in the event one (1) candidate receives a majority of votes cast for all candidates for nomination to a particular Council District seat, the candidate receiving the majority of votes shall be deemed to be and declared by the Council to be elected to such office, all in accordance with Charter section 10.

Section 3. For the purpose of the primary election, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said election.

Section 5. That the polls for said election shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, September 19, 1995.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 7. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

Inspectors	\$50.00*
Clerks	\$35.00
Rental of Polling Place	\$25.00

*Compensation provides for ballot box returns.

Section 8. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 9. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
