AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING FOR THE TEMPORARY INSTALLATION OF PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING MACHINES.

WHEREAS, the City has an effective parking meter program that enhances the flow of vehicles in the City; and

WHEREAS, there is new technology which the Manager desires to evaluate to see if it can facilitate the more efficient use of sidewalk areas; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager desires to install and test the feasibility of Multispace Parking Meters also known as "Pay and Display" Parking Meters; and

WHEREAS, the use of the Pay and Display Parking Meters may be inconsistent with other provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code as it is currently written; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to establish Pay and Display Parking Meters test areas under the following conditions:

- 1. All test areas for Pay and Display Parking Meters shall be located within the boundaries of Parking Meter Rate Zone A.
- 2. No person shall permit a vehicle to remain parked in a Pay and Display Parking Meter Test area when the Pay and Display Parking Meter receipt has expired.

- 3. The provisions of San Diego Municipal Code sections 82.06 and 86.12 of the Municipal Code relating to the curbside location of parking meters shall not apply in the Pay and Display Parking Meter Test areas.
- 4. All other provisions of San Diego Municipal Code relating to parking of vehicles are applicable in any designated Pay and Display Parking Meter test area.
- 5. This ordinance shall expire and be of no further force and effect six months from the date it first becomes effective.

Section 1. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
