

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 285208

ADOPTED ON JAN 17 1995

WHEREAS, the California Office of Traffic Safety has selected the California Highway Patrol to receive a grant called "Statewide Preliminary Alcohol Screening (PAS) Device Distribution Project," the primary purpose of which is to provide PAS (breath testing) devices to law enforcement agencies throughout California; and

WHEREAS, the California Highway Patrol wishes to provide two hundred thirty (230) of these devices to the San Diego Police Department, and train Police Department personnel in their use, for the purpose of detecting intoxicated drivers, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to accept and place into use said Preliminary Alcohol Screening devices from the California Highway Patrol for the above-named program as described in the award document and letter attached, copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 285208.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute all aspects of program operation including any amendments, extensions, renewals, or future funding for this program for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the California Office of Traffic Safety and/or the California Highway Patrol, and to certify that

the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

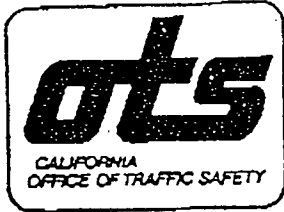

Project funds provide for the purchase of 2,785 PAS devices. Four-hundred of the devices will be retained by the CHP and 2,385 devices will be distributed to other law enforcement agencies throughout California. The CHP will provide allied agency training in the use and calibration of the devices. Funding also provides for alcohol simulators; a laptop computer, software, and portable printer; and training travel expenses. The project objective is to distribute 2,785 PAS devices to California law enforcement agencies for use in traffic safety activities which will result in the detection and apprehension of drinking drivers.

6. FEDERAL FUNDS ALLOCATED UNDER THIS AGREEMENT SHALL NOT EXCEED \$ 1,750,000.00

The California Highway Patrol (CHP), in cooperation with the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS), is pleased to inform you that your agency will be receiving preliminary alcohol screening (PAS) device(s) funded through OTS grant AL 9422, Statewide Preliminary Alcohol Screening Device Distribution Project. The bid purchase for the PAS devices was awarded to Intoximeters, Inc. for their Alco-Sensor IV's. The devices are being shipped to CHP Headquarters for inventory and will be delivered to CHP field divisions for distribution and training.
