WHEREAS, the Foreign Trade Zones Board of the United States Department of Commerce has authorized The City of San Diego, California, to establish and operate Foreign Trade Zone No. 153 and such alternate sites and special purpose subzones as are necessary to serve commerce and industry in the San Diego area; and

WHEREAS, Calbiochem-Novabiochem International ("Calbiochem") is a valued biochemical industrial concern in the San Diego area; and


WHEREAS, Calbiochem has need of a special purpose subzone for its continued operations in the City of San Diego and has requested the City to apply to the Foreign Trade Zones Board for authority to establish a subzone of Foreign Trade Zone No. 153 for use by Calbiochem; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it hereby authorizes the City Manager to file documents requesting the Foreign Trade Zones Board, International Trade Administration, United States Department of Commerce, to execute the application for a special purpose subzone in accordance with regulations pursuant to federal law (15 C.F.R. Part 400) for the

use and benefit of Calbiochem and further authorizing the City Manager to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to complete the authorization process.
